- Please review our ordinances **before starting any** additions or construction projects on land or water (including floating jet ski docks and fences).
- Starting a project before receiving a building permit will result in a “Stop Work Order”, higher fees and possible removal of your project.
- For any building permit questions, property owners can call City Hall at (830) 265-4366.

HH Water System

- Avoid late fees and save time!! If you are tired of writing a check every month for your water service, you can pay in advance. The credit amount will appear on each of your next bills. Once the amount gets low or you have an amount due, simply write another check for an advance payment.

Streets and Drainage

- Check drainage areas around your home and make sure culverts are open and drainage ditches (swales) between houses are maintained so storm water is carried away.

Emergency Preparedness / FEMA Hazard Mitigation Plans

- Spring in Central Texas brings all types of weather. Please consider registering with this program to get emergency announcements.

- Register to get emergency warnings in your neighborhood by text, email or phone.
- Registering with WarnCentralTexas allows emergency personnel in your local community to directly contact you by phone, text or email during a disaster or public safety event. Using WarnCentralTexas, emergency response teams can warn residents about dangerous conditions and situations as events unfold. They can quickly give specific directions that affect your neighborhood such as evacuation orders and directions to shelters.
