POA volunteers have been busy throughout the summer months trimming, mowing and providing general maintenance in our parks, storage area and around the community center and City Hall. You may have noticed the dead mesquite tree in Highland West has been removed. Special thanks to **Chris & Debbie Boldt**, **Robert & Debbie Dahlstrom** and **Ray Estrada** for getting that done. We also have a new volunteer maintaining Highland East, **David Newton**. Thanks to all of our many volunteers for your contributions for our community.

Since August, 86.5 hours of labor were volunteered. The total of volunteer hours contributed year to date has been 284. Without our volunteers we would need to contract these services. At a modest rate of \$15.00 an hour, we would have spent \$4,260 so far this year.

As a reminder, boaters and those on the water need to be vigilant to stop the spread of zebra mussels. Boaters must clean, drain and dry their boats to keep zebra mussels from spreading. It's the law – with fines up to \$500 for a first offense. State regulations require all boats operating on public freshwater anywhere in Texas to be drained after use to help prevent the spread of zebra mussels and other aquatic invasive species.
