City elections are scheduled for May 2, 2020. <u>Candidate filing is scheduled for January 15 through February 14, 2020</u>. Anyone interested in filing should contact Jeannie Gruetzner, Highland Haven City Secretary. We will have 4 alderman and the mayor positions scheduled for this election. Alderman and the mayor serve 2-year terms

and the terms are staggered. Three (3) alderman positions are scheduled for election every other year and 2 alderman and the mayor positions in the alternate year.

The mayor and 2 alderman positions would typically be scheduled for the May 2020 ballot. Incumbents who will be completing their 2-year terms include Alderman **Don Hagans**, Alderman **Terry Nuss** and Mayor **Olan Kelley**. Alderman Terry Smith was appointed, and that position must be included on the ballot for a one-year term. **Lonnie Ball**, our Mayor Pro Tem, will be moving and that position will also be on the ballot. All our aldermen have been great leaders and we have faith we will continue to have the same caliber of leadership in the future.

# **Building Permits for Dock Repairs**

# Important Information Regarding Building Permits during the Lake LBJ Drawdown

The LCRA lowered Lake LBJ on January 2, 2020 and the lake will be refilled, beginning February 24. LCRA permits are not required for dock repairs while the lake is lowered. However, per City ordinances, the City of Highland Haven will continue to require permitting of waterfront projects, during the above referenced time period. Please keep in mind waterfront permits require the approval/signature of two members of the Planning and Zoning Board, along with the Building Permit officer and another city official (mayor or alderman). We do not want to see any projects delayed, so if you plan to complete anything beyond minor repairs to your waterfront structures, it is critical you review Ordinances #56 and #20 <a href="https://highlandhaventx.com/ordinances-resolutions/">https://highlandhaventx.com/ordinances-resolutions/</a> and contact the City as early as possible. Waterfront permits typically take a minimum of a week to process. The following is a list of items required for Waterfront Building Permits:

- Completed Application
- License Information for Contractors (copies)
- Certified Site Survey
- Ownership verified
- Site Plan showing location of construction
- Construction Plan, (Drawings, descriptions, CAD)
- Set back acknowledgement, Owner/Contractor
- Planning and Zoning Approval
- Fees Paid


### **Next HHLC Potluck Dinner:** Tuesday January 18 @ 6pm.
