## COVID-19

- Most have probably seen reports from news agencies that COVID cases are increasing across Texas. Highland Haven has had several cases reported in our community as well. Please use the resources below to help us keep our community safe and healthy. Maintain social distancing, avoid gatherings (especially indoors), wash your hands frequently and wear a mask to protect you and others.
- City Hall is again closed to the public due to the recent increase of COVID cases. We continued to experience walk-in visitors that were not wearing masks, and this puts our staff at risk. We are still available by phone and email.

#### **Board of Alderman**

- The 2% sales tax included on the November election ballot was passed. The Board approved the election canvassing and documentation is being processed through the Texas Comptroller's Office to implement the tax. According to the Texas Comptroller's Office it will take 4-5 months before the tax can be implemented.
- The Board approved a 10-year extension of our right-of-way contract with the Pedernales Electric Cooperative which includes an increase of the franchise fee from 2% to 4%. Residents can expect to see a letter from PEC regarding this change. The change will not be effective for several months.
- BOA meetings are open to the public. Residents and property owners are encouraged to attend.
- No regular Board of Alderman meetings are scheduled for December. Special called meetings may be scheduled and posted should the Board have any issues that may need immediate action.
- Next BOA meeting is scheduled for January 5, 2021.
- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the BOA meetings are held in the Community Center to provide space for social distancing. Face masks are required. Seating is limited.
- City Offices will be closed November 26-27 for Thanksgiving Holidays.

## Public Safety/Street Maintenance

The Board approved changing the "YIELD" sign at 100 Flamingo to a "STOP" sign. Residents have been concerned about traffic safety at this location due to limited sight lines.



- The intersection of Redbird and Blackbird is now a 3-way STOP. Residents continue to report unsafe drivers that are not stopping at this intersection. We have asked the Sheriff's Office to monitor this intersection.
- To keep our streets safe, please advise residents, guests, and contractors to observe traffic laws and be safe while walking on our streets.
- Let's keep our streets safe for everyone!

#### **Solid Waste Service**

- We now have 25% of our utility customers using ACH! This is outstanding! The ACH program helps us reduce staff time necessary to process cash and check payments and helps customers avoid late fees.

### **Planning and Zoning Commission**

- The next P&Z Meeting is scheduled for **Thursday**, **December 10**, **6pm**. This meeting will be held in the Community Center to provide area for "social distancing".
- These meetings are open to the public, residents and property owners are encouraged to attend.

#### Fire Safety

- <u>Burn Ban has been lifted</u> and outdoor fires are now allowed; however, dry conditions prevail across Burnet County so <u>contact Granite Shoals Fire Dept.</u> and the Burnet County Sheriff's Office prior to starting any outdoor fires.
- Outdoor fires must be continually monitored and must be completely out by sundown.
- Be kind to your neighbors and manage your burning to reduce producing smoke. We recently had complaints from residents across several blocks about a smoldering stack of leaves left burning overnight.
