Trees and Shrubs

- We are receiving complaints about low tree limbs that extend over some streets. Please check and make sure your tree limbs are trimmed back to provide a minimum clearance of 15' above streets to accommodate emergency vehicles, trash trucks and RV's.
- Property owners need to review their trees and contact Pedernales Electric Cooperative if you have limbs that could damage powerlines. Better to call now to be prepared for any possible ice storms this winter.
