- BOA meetings are open to the public. Residents and property owners are encouraged to attend. Meetings are normally scheduled on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of each month at the Community Center.

Water Conservation

- As a public water system, we are required by TCEQ, TWDB, and the Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District to have a drought contingency plan. The Board of Aldermen has been reviewing our draft *Drought Contingency Plan* during their regular meetings, and a public hearing was scheduled at the BOA meeting on Tuesday September 17, 2024, at the Community Center. The BOA approved the plan at the September 17th meeting.

- The Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District met on August 19th and chose to continue 10% MANDATORY Drought Water Reductions for all exempt and non-exempt water wells. These reductions are effective through December 31, 2024. More details can be found by clicking here: <u>Drought Status</u>.
- The City of Highland Haven groundwater permit has been reduced from 82-acre feet to 73-acre feet; therefore, all Highland Haven water customers are required to continue their efforts to reduce water use.
- The City of Highland Haven follows the LCRA outdoor watering schedule:
 - Wednesdays and Saturdays for addresses ending in odd numbers.
 - Thursdays and Sundays for addresses ending in even numbers.
 - o Hours: Midnight to 10 AM and 7 PM to midnight.
 - November through February: No watering.

In our Biannual Meeting (and July Newsletter) we discussed the POA efforts around water weed treatments for Dove Park swim area and boat ramp. As per LCRA/TPWD rules, we hired approved contractors and applied for required permits. During the months of May and June two different herbicide applications were done to treat the aquatic weeds and algae. We also applied for reimbursement to the LCRA weed treatment rebate program.

We are delighted to report that we were notified that we will receive a reimbursement, within the next few weeks! This will allow us to redirect funds to other important areas.
