Trees and Shrubs

- Property owners need to review their trees and contact Pedernales Electric Cooperative if you have limbs that could damage powerlines. Better to call now to be prepared for any possible ice storms this winter.
- Please check and make sure your tree limbs are trimmed back to provide a minimum clearance of 15' above streets to accommodate emergency vehicles, trash trucks and RV's.

Public Safety

- We have received reports from many residents regarding harassment by a lawn care solicitor.
- Contact the Burnet County Sheriff's Office immediately should you be concerned about your or a neighbor's safety.
