#### **Board of Alderman**

The Board of Alderman has been diligently working the last month to finalize the City's budgets for the next fiscal year (October 1- September 30). We are faced with a number of challenges in the upcoming year, which will have a financial impact on all of us. The proposed budgets have been submitted to the City Secretary.

#### **Highland Haven Operating Budget**

For the second time in our City's history, there will be a "changing of the guard". Dana Turner, our City Secretary, has submitted her resignation effective February 28, 2017. Dana is a very dedicated and dynamic person who has been serving in this role for approximately 8 years. The current position is half paid and half volunteer. Filling this vacancy will be a priority for the Board.

The City Secretary is a position mandated by the State Constitution and as such is a critical position to our city organization. There are many important roles performed by this position such as records management, financial management, election coordinator, municipal court clerk and water system coordination (billing, purchasing, and records management). One of the most important responsibilities is supporting our elected officials. Most citizens who serve on the Board of Alderman and the Planning and Zoning Committee know very little about the behind the scenes responsibilities of running our city and the City Secretary position helps educate and coordinate these volunteers.

We run a very "tight ship" and the upcoming budget will need to include fully funding the City Secretary position along with our regular city programs. This cost increase will require the Board to consider raising our property taxes. Our current tax rate is insufficient to offset this new funding requirement. The Board is considering increasing our tax rate to .1110/\$100 of property valuation. This change will generate about \$10,000, just enough to cover these extra costs. Even with this change, Highland Haven will still enjoy the lowest property tax rate for any community in our area.

#### **Highland Haven Water System Budget**

With great foresight, our City purchased our water system in 2009. As most will agree, the water system is a great asset providing us with a safe dependable water service. The system was built in the 1980's and the system has been well maintained and continues to serve our area well. Our service area includes Highland Haven, Shady Acres, Nobles and Camp Champions. The Texas Commission on

Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has rules to which all municipal water systems must comply regarding service delivery and safety of drinking water. Revenues generated by the water system are used to manage our system and upgrade critical system components when necessary.

Regular operating costs have risen since our last rate increase in 2011. The Board must consider several options to keep our system in the best position to serve our customers. A 6% rate increase is currently being considered. This rate increase will raise our monthly base rate from \$32 to \$34/2,000 gallons.

The Board of Alderman will continue to deliberate and refine these budgets over the next month. The Board is scheduled to hold a Public Hearing and adopt the FY17 budgets and tax rate by September 20<sup>th</sup>.

  - "(4) Political signs during City, County, State, and Federal elections, may be posted on lots and residential tracts developed with a single family residence provided the sign is located inside the boundary lines of the specific property. Signs are not to exceed 24" by 36" and are <u>limited to one per</u> candidate per lot or residential tract of land."

#### Lot Maintenance

- Dead trees and brush piles need to be removed to lessen fire hazards.
- Property owners are responsible for maintaining right of way areas abutting their property.
- Check the drainage areas around your home and make sure that the culverts are open and drainage ditches (swales) between houses are maintained so storm water is carried away.
