Ord. #58 states "Leaves, grass or other refuse shall not be blown, raked, discharged or otherwise disposed of into canals, lake, streets or drainage infrastructure." Please pass along this info to your lawn contractors.

- Cart drivers must be licensed drivers and must obey all traffic laws. Ord. #59
- Please slow down and watch for pedestrians, bicycles and slow moving golf carts.

- Please review our ordinances before starting <u>any</u> additions or construction projects on land or water (including floating Jet Ski docks and fences).
- Starting a project before receiving a building permit will result in a "Stop Work Order", higher fees and possible removal of your project.

Watercraft Safety in Highland Haven

- A number of residents have recently complained about watercraft speeding through channels and coves inside the "No Wake Zones" surrounding Highland Haven. Please visit with all guests and watercraft operators and advise them to observe "No Wake Zones".
- Highland Haven Ordinance #59 Section V. WATERCRAFT states:
 - Operation of watercraft: The operation of watercraft as to registration, license requirements, safety equipment, and speed, both on the dredged canals and the waters of Lake LBJ within the City corporate limits, shall be in conformance with the published rules of the Lower Colorado River Authority and the Texas Parks and Wildlife Commission. Observance of "No Wake" speed is required."
- According to LCRA and TPWD: It is unlawful to operate a watercraft within a designated "No Wake" area except at headway speed **without creating a swell or wake**.
- **Olan Kelley** and **Lonnie Ball** met with LCRA representatives recently to verify our LCRA "No Wake" Buoy Permit and buoy placement.
- Any buoys placed in the lake must be permitted by LCRA, not including temporary fishing trotline buoys which are managed by Texas Parks and Wildlife Department.

HH Water System

- <u>Time Savings Tip!!</u> Water customers can pay in advance! Your credit balance will appear on each of your next bills. Once your account gets low, simply write another check to increase your account credit balance.

Streets and Drainage

- It is dry now; however, when the next Texas thunderstorm occurs property owners can be faced with flooding problems.
- Property owners are responsible for keeping driveway culverts/pipes open and drainage ditches/swales along streets and between houses maintained so storm water is carried away from homes.

Emergency Preparedness / FEMA Hazard Mitigation Plans

- o Fire Ban is in Effect! (Effective 6/27/2017)
- No outdoor fires are allowed!
- Brush and clippings should be removed from properties and not stacked. Brush piles create a huge fire risk!
- o A recent structure fire in Camp Champions destroyed a staff residence. Please cleanup around your property and help reduce our fire risk!
- Ord. #58 "Piles of brush, logs, tree limbs, weeds, scrap lumber, dirt, gravel, construction debris, etc. will not be allowed to accumulate. Neatly stacked firewood is permissible. Piles of brush, logs, tree limbs, weeds, scrap lumber, dirt, gravel, construction debris, etc. will be removed after fourteen days."
