HH Water System

- <u>Time Savings Tip!!</u> Water customers can pay in advance! Your credit balance will appear on each of your next bills. Once your account gets low, or you have an amount due, simply write another check to update your account balance.

Streets and Drainage

- Check the drainage areas around your home and make sure that the culverts are open and drainage ditches (swales) between houses are maintained so storm water is carried away.

Emergency Preparedness / FEMA Hazard Mitigation Plans

- Due to hot dry summer weather, be careful with any outdoor fires. See Ord. #27
 - o Do not leave a fire unattended
 - o Have a water hose close by to quickly extinguish it
 - Outdoor fires must be completely extinguished by sundown.

Happy 4th of July! As we celebrate our country's independence our community will swell with visiting family and friends. That also means our parks and streets will be busy.

We encourage you to utilize the parks and our improved swimming area in Dove Park. A few items to keep in mind....

- No overnight parking/camping is permitted in the parks.
- Excessive noise is prohibited in the parks.
- All persons in the park will remain clear of the boat ramp while swimming or playing. The boat ramp is exclusively reserved for the launching and recovery of boats. Parking is not allowed on the boat ramp.
- All parties enjoying and participating in motor boating and jet skiing will remain a minimum of 15 feet offshore except when launching, recovering or beaching watercraft.
- Children under the age of 12 must be attended by an adult property owner or their guest. Underage consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed in the parks.
- Fireworks of any type are not permitted in the Parks.

If you need a guest pass for family/friends to park a vehicle in the park while using the park or while on the water - contact any Board Member. Passes are \$5.00 and are good for up to a week.
