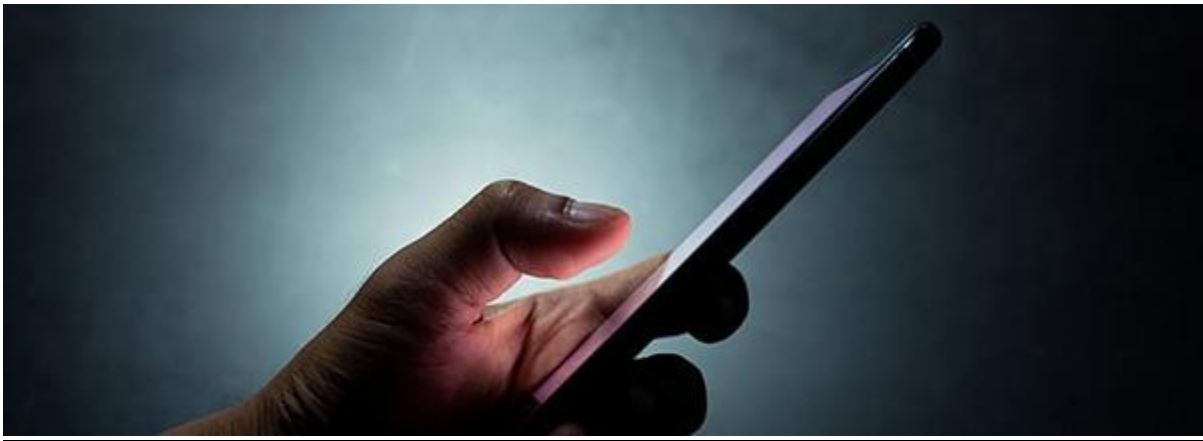

The Lower Colorado River Authority is commemorating the 30th anniversary of its program by awarding two grants of up to \$100,000.
