The Eagle Recreation Department was formed in 2002. It is funded by the Town and Village of Eagle. Since 2002, soccer and baseball have been enjoyed by more than 200 children per season. We have added yoga, craft classes, senior events, pickleball, basketball, family events, and much more! We are continually looking for ways to generate income to subsidize costs. The Town and Village of Eagle Boards govern the Recreation Department Committee. The Committee is comprised of one member from the Village Board, one member from the Town Board, one village resident, one town resident, and the Director of the Eagle Recreation Department. Their respective Boards appoint members. The Recreation Committee will be directly responsible for all Eagle Recreation decisions involving budget, expenditures of funds, policies, and programs offered by the Eagle Recreation Department. The Eagle Recreation Department Committee is also responsible for the direct supervision of the Recreation Director.

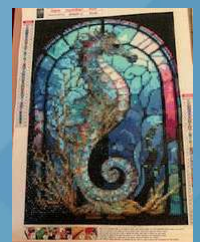

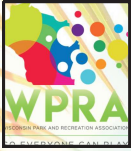
