GARBAGE/RECYCLING UPDATES

**Please note that garbage pick-up will be on Friday, July 3
which is our normal pick up date**

Holiday and other reminders:

- Village offices are closed on July 3 and September 7 for Independence Day and Labor Day.
- The **Compost site will be closed on Saturday July 4 due to the holiday**
- The **Compost site will be closed on Labor Day, Monday September 7.**
- The Second Installment Real Estate Taxes are due July 31, 2026. Please pay taxes at the Portage County Courthouse or online through the Portage County website.

Utility bill payment options

- **Direct pay** option can be done quarterly. This is an automatic withdrawal from your checking or savings account. Please stop in the office with a voided check to set this option up.
- **Cash, personal check or money order.** Mail in or drop off at the office. There is also an after hours drop box available to the right of the main doors.
- **Credit card or e-check payment using Gov Pay.** Visit www.villageofwhiting.org and use the “Pay Water & Sewer Bills” link. There is a 2.95% service fee for credit cards and a flat \$2.95 fee when using an e-check.

Recycling Updates

- Please bring any used or unwanted fire extinguishers to the Village office. The Plover Fire Department is picking them up and disposing of them for us.
- We are no longer taking candles/wax. Opportunity Development Centers (ODC) is the program we were giving them to, so you may want to reach out to them if you want to continue donating old candles: www.odcinc.com.
- We are sorry to say that we will no longer be a collection site for Christmas Lights this year as we had too many issues with items being brought in that did not qualify.
