

Clark County ATV/UTV Trails open May 9th

The Clark County Forest ATV/UTV trails are in good condition so they will open early on May 9, 2015. Trails are still wet in spots and vulnerable to damage from excessive acceleration and speed, so please ride responsibly to help reduce maintenance costs and avoid resource damage. Off trail riding is strictly prohibited.

UTV's are allowed on the Clark County ATV Trail system during the summer. Street legal motorcycles, driven by licensed drivers are allowed on the trail system. Non-street legal motorcycles are not allowed on the trail system.

A 2.5 mile section of the trail system from intersection 19 (Koehler's Ford Forest Road Web Center) to intersection 20 (Eau Claire County line) remains closed. The trail closure is clearly marked and is indicated on the new ATV maps. Trail damage at this location has created a serious safety concern with the Koch pipeline. This section of the trail will be closed indefinitely. The Eau Claire County connector is also closed. There is no access to Eau Claire county ATV trails at this location.
