It's time for Spring Cleanup!

The Village of Withee appreciates your cooperation with making our village look its best. The Village employees, Village Board members, and the O-W Police Department will be working together to monitor the municipality for any ordinance violations pertaining to any of the following:

Sec. 10-5-8

It shall be unlawful to have disassembled, inoperable, unlicensed, junked or wrecked vehicles, vehicle parts, truck bodies, tractors, trailers, farm machinery, appliances, household furnishings or construction debris on your property.



Sec. 6-2-15

It shall be unlawful to place, throw, leave, in any way deposit or permit to be deposited, or permit to remain any dirt, leaves, rubbish, litter, debris or material of any kind upon any street, sidewalk, alley, drainage way, or public ground in the Village.



Sec. 6-2-13

The owner of the premises shall cause to be affixed and to be maintained when so affixed to each principal building the official house number assigned to that building. The numbers shall be of contrasting color and no less than 2 1/2 inches high on a background of not less than 3 inches.



Sec. 8-1-4 and 8-1-5

The premises shall be free of all noxious weeds. A complete list of noxious weeds is available at the Village Hall. The premises shall not have a length of grass or weeds that exceeds 8" in height. If either of the sections is violated and notice has been given, the Village may choose to eliminate the weeds or grass and bill the amount to the owner.



Sec. 11-6-5(h)

All buildings or structures so old, dilapidated or out of repair as to be dangerous, unsafe, unsanitary or otherwise unfit for human use should be taken down.



Dog Licensing



All dogs in the Village of Withee are required to be licensed by April 1, 2023. If you have not obtained a dog license this year, please do so as soon as possible. There will be an additional \$5.00 late fee after April 1. Bring in the certificate of vaccination as proof of rabies shots at the time you purchase a license. Please note dogs must be leashed and dog poop must be picked up when walking your dog.
