Resolution Adopting the Port Edwards Safe Routes to School Plan

WHEREAS, the Village of Port Edwards, Wood County, supports improving walking and biking routes for students to get to school; and

WHEREAS, the health and safety of children is of highest concern to the citizens of the Village of Port Edwards; and

WHEREAS, Safe Routes to School efforts help remove barriers to walking and biking to school, and reduce traffic congestion and speed in and around schools; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) requires, that in order to be eligible for funding of needed projects, municipalities and/or school districts must either create or amend their SRTS Plan to include needed projects; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Port Edwards has developed a Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Plan for the dual purposes of serving as a guide for future programming and infrastructure improvements (the 5 E's of education, encouragement, engineering, enforcement, and evaluation); and to be eligible for various funding programs including WisDOT's Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP grant); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Port Edwards had staff on the SRTS Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the SRTS Task Force collected data, reviewed the results, and provided direction for SRTS Plan development, and then incorporated those results into the SRTS Plan; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Port Edwards hereby adopts Resolution 2026-07.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village of Port Edwards staff is directed to begin implementing this SRTS Plan.
