

Building Permits

- The Town of Harrison requires permits before starting construction and includes the installation of mobile homes.
- Permits can be obtained by completing an application available on website or from the Town Clerk; Kathy Kloes 715-623-6931 clerk@townofharrisonmcwi.gov
- Applications must include full payment to be considered by the Town Board:
 - o Fees are as follows:
 - Any new residential building \$50
 - Any new non-residential building or changes in building dimensions \$10
- The Town of Harrison Board will review all applications and make a decision on the permit at the Board meeting following the receipt of application (Board meetings are typically held the second Tuesday of each month).
- Before getting a building permit, for any new access on all roads, you must get a driveway permit. Driveway permits are available from Town Chairman
- Minor structures not requiring a building permit shall include any small easily movable construction and any structure which is no more than 400 square feet (no foundation) or cost no more than \$5000 in materials.
- PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION IN THE TOWN OF HARRISON PLEASE NOTE
 - o The property that you are planning to build on may have wetlands and/or shoreland/floodplain zoning that Marathon County administers (see maps at Town Hall) - contact Marathon County Planning & Zoning at 715.261.6000 for required permits.
 - o Septic System permits are issued by Marathon County Planning & Zoning at 715.261.6000.
