DECEMBER 2025

As of January 1, 2026, the County Clerk's Office will be distributing all dog license tags, this will no longer be done through your municipal treasurer. There are multiple ways to obtain a license.

1. Mail your rabies certificate and check **(make sure personal information is up to date):**

Click on "Departments," then "County Clerk," then "Dog License," and follow the prompts. Once you submit your information you can pay online or mail the payment.

DOG LICENSING

ALL dogs 5 months of age or older require a license, per Sec. 174.05(1), Wis. Stats. The license year commences on January 1 and ends on the following December 31. Proof of current immunization against rabies must be presented at the time the license is requested. If you cannot find your dog's rabies vaccination certificate, a duplicate copy must be obtained from your veterinarian.

License fees are \$15 for unneutered or unspayed dogs, and \$10 for neutered or spayed dogs. In Waushara County, those wishing to keep more than 5 adult dogs on their property must apply for and obtain a kennel license. (If you live within city or village limits, different limits may apply.) **A multiple dog/kennel license is \$50 for the first 12 dogs, and \$5 for each dog after 12 dogs.** Kennel licenses are issued only after an owner has obtained approval from the County's Zoning, Health and Sheriff's departments.

PENALTIES

After March 31, a late fee of \$5 per dog shall be assessed to the owner **obtaining a dog license for any dogs older than 5 months of age** (Sec. 174.05(5), Wis. Stats.). **Owners not licensing their dogs may also be subject to County and/or municipal citations.** In addition, an owner who fails to have a dog vaccinated against rabies as required by statute may be required to forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$100, plus court costs.

Before JANUARY 31ST, 2026 MAIL YOUR PAYMENTS AS FOLLOWS

Real Estate taxes are due January 31, 2026. If you use the installment plan, the first payment is due January 31, paid to the town treasurer. The second installment is due on or before July 31, 2026, payable to Waushara County Treasurer, Jessica Jaeger, 380 S Townline Rd, Wautoma, WI 54982.

All special assessments, special charges and special taxes are due on **January 31, 2026.**

Postmark must be no later than January 31, 2026.
(I use the Postmark date for the payment date.)

Enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope if you need a receipt. Tax receipt is not valid until check has cleared the bank.

LOTTERY CREDIT: If a lottery credit does not appear on your tax bill for your primary residence, please complete form # LC-110. Form is available online @ WIDOR/Forms/LOTTERY & GAMING Credit form #LC-100.

And forward the completed form to me. A primary residence is where you live most of the time, and you are entitled to only one credit. If you currently receive the lottery credit, your certification automatically continues. The law requires that you notify the county treasurer within 30 days after you no longer qualify for the credit either because you no longer own the property or you no longer use it as your primary residence.
