RESOLUTION PROPOSED LOCAL LAW 2 of 2025

At a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Stamford, held at the Village Hall in said Village, County of Delaware and State of New York, on the 20th day of May, 2025 at 6:45pm.

The Village of Stamford offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Village of Stamford (the "Village") by and through its Board of Trustees (the "Board") has the power to adopt local laws not inconsistent with the provisions of the constitution or not inconsistent with any general law relating to its property, affairs or government, pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law § 10(1)(i); and

WHEREAS, the Board introduced Local Law No. 2 of 2025, Call Before You Dig Regulations of the Village of Stamford, and thereafter held a properly-noticed public hearing as to whether the Board should adopt such local law on May 20, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Board, having conducted said public hearing and considered any and all comments from the public at such public hearing, desires to adopt Local Law No. 2 of 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Stamford Board of Trustees enacts this Local Law where the purpose of this law is to codify within Village Law, procedures for the protection of underground facilities & utilities in order to assure public and to prevent damage to property, both private and public (i.e. property of the Village of Stamford); as provided for in NYCRR 16 Part 753, NYS Public Service Law § 119-b and NYS General Business Law Article 36.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed law is ready for consideration by the Village Board; and
