May 2025 Attention Village Residents:

There are <u>3 very important notices</u> to bring to your attention regarding water/sewer services:

1. Beginning July 1, 2025 there will be a change to the sewer rates. Sewer rates have not been adjusted since 2018.

New Sewer rates based on metered water usage & water rates:

There will be a \$20 capital charge for every sewer unit. The bare minimum sewer rate for a single unit household using less than 5000 gal of water per quarter will be \$59.

\$39.00 for the first 5000 gallons (minimum rate + \$20 capital charge) From 5,001 gallons to 8,000 gallons - \$8.75 per thousand gallons From 8,001 gallons to 10,000 gallons - \$9.50 per thousand gallons From 10,001 gallons to 12,000 gallons - \$10.50 per thousand gallons From 12,001 gallons to 14,000 gallons - \$11.25 per thousand gallons From 14,001 gallons to 16,000 gallons - \$12.25 per thousand gallons >16,000 gallons - \$13.25 per thousand gallons

- 2. This is a <u>third</u> public notice to inform all Village of Stamford property owners, business and residential, that all water meters need to be replaced per state mandate. The old meters have surpassed their life span of approximately 15-20 years. It is imperative that all of the meters get replaced as soon as possible. Please call the clerk at 607-652-6671 to schedule your meter replacement. The Village DPW needs everyone's cooperation. If your water meter has already been replaced, please disregard this notice.
- 3. As stated in Local Law No. 1 adopted in 1995, "The Village will maintain meters where ordinary wear and tear is concerned, but in the case of damage and freezing, hot water or external damage, the customer will be held responsible for repairs." The Village of Stamford will replace the frost plate one time, free of charge, but in the case of second mishap, the business/home owner will be responsible for the cost of a new frost plate, that cost to the property owner is \$100.00 each time it breaks after that. If a commercial meter breaks with no frost plate, the Commercial business owner will be responsible for the cost of the replacement meter.
