

RESOLUTION # 2 of 2026

RESOLUTION SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED LOCAL LAW

The Village of Stamford offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Village of Stamford, Board of Trustees has determined that amendments to the existing planning board bylaws are necessary to address the challenges of assembling a Planning Board in a small Village setting; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held to discuss the proposed amendments, and all interested parties were given the opportunity to attend said public hearing;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Stamford, Board of Trustees hereby approves the following amendments to the planning board bylaws:

1. Amend the bylaws such that persons appointed to the Planning Board must be a resident of the Village of Stamford, the Town of Stamford or the Town of Harpersfield, and own a business or property in the Village of Stamford.
2. Amend the bylaws such that newly appointed members must receive New York State, Department of State, or equivalent training as approved by the Board of Trustees, overview training for the position to which they have been appointed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be in effect immediately upon passage and that the updated planning board bylaws shall be made available for public inspection at Stamford Village Hall.
