

RESOLUTION #6 OF 2026

RESOLUTION ADOPTING NEW REVISION TO THE WATER LAW INCLUDING FEES FOR NOT ALLOWING DPW ACCESS TO THE WATER METER AND FROST PLATE REPLACEMENT FOR THE VILLAGE OF STAMFORD

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Village of Stamford (“Village Board”) has adopted local laws to amend the fees associated with non-payment shut offs and the property owner’s responsibility when there are frozen pipes; and

WHEREAS, under these laws, the property owner will grant the Water Department the right of access to property to inspect, test and replace any meter; and

WHEREAS, The Village Board of Trustees shall review the total cost of operation and maintenance of the water system annually and shall have the power to set, change, or amend the rates and penalties charged, following a Public Hearing subject to the provisions of Article 21 of the Village Law; and


