

RESOLUTION # 9 of 2026

RESOLUTION TO SET NEW WATER CAPITAL FEE

At a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Stamford, held at the Village Hall in said Village, County of Delaware and State of New York, on the 16th day of June, 2026 at 7:00pm, there were present: Robert Schneider, Clifford Curley, Jim Kopp, Catherine Snyder, Robert Orcutt.

The Village of Stamford offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Village of Stamford Water Use Law provides that water use rates and fees can be set by a Village Board resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Village Treasurer has reviewed the proposed budget for the municipal water system, including the debt incurred for the Capital Water Project, with the system operator and has made a recommendation to the Village Board of Trustees ("Village Board") that the water use rate should be reassessed and recalculated for 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has considered this recommendation and the proposed budget for the municipal water system and finds that a capital fee is necessary to sufficiently pay the debt. This fee would cover the entire cost of the loan each year and allow the Village to continue to use the normal water rates for regular operation and maintenance of the facility and distribution system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this capital fee will be at \$40 per water meter. The rate will go into effect on July 1, 2026:

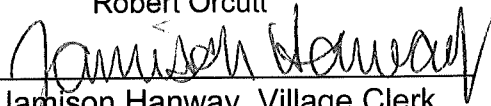
