PLOWING OF PRIVATE ROADS

Hereafter:

The Town will plow private roads, only when:

- 1. The way has been plowed for the past three years (2 or more residences located thereon).
- 2. The way is of suitable width for Town Highway trucks to negotiate.
- 3. There is adequate turn around if one is needed.
- 4. New ways will be plowed if there are two or more residences located on said way, where the distance to be plowed is not over ½ mile, or in the case of 3 or more, the Town will not plow farther than ½ mile on private ways unless residences are located no farther than 500 feet apart.
- 5. The Town assumes no responsibility to plow any private way when, in the opinion of the driver, there is unreasonable danger to the equipment.
- 6. The Town assumes no responsibility for plowing of private ways until all public ways are cleared.
