## INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A BUILDING PERMIT

- 1- A complete set of plans showing to scale and in detail the following information:
  - a) Building elevation plans showing all sides of the building in relation to the final grading.
  - b) Building floor plans showing all floor levels of the building including the basement.
  - c) Building structural plans (cross section) showing all structural components from the bottom of the footing to the top of the roof.
  - d) Building smoke detector locations/CO detectors, fire protection systems for all floor levels of the building, including the basement.

e) Building insulation/ventilation plans, (Res-check or like programs) are a must.

- f) Other information deemed necessary by the Inspector of Buildings for proper building Plan review.
- g) All structures with engineered beams (steel and wood) will need documentation relative to the proper installation.

2- A driveway permit issued by the Town Highway Department.

- 3- An approved sewage disposal system plan with the construction permit issued by the Board of Health.
- 4- A copy of the water test or a letter from the appropriate water company which will supply water to the lot.
- 5- A plot plan of the lot showing all the boundary lines with dimensions, all of the existing and Proposed buildings and their setbacks from the property lines, the dimension for the street Frontage, size of the lot in square feet, and the map and parcel number (available from the Assessors office), <u>Delineation of all wetlands</u>.
- 6- Conservation approval (before submitting permit application), on all applications.

7- Copy of the deed.

8- Copy of the contractors Construction Supervisors License.

9- Copy of the contractors Home Improvement Registration number if applicable.

10-Certificate of Workers Compensation instrumee or signed insurance affidavit.
