Old Business

- 1. Check for windows was received and deposited into the money market.

New Business

- 1. Terry Leninger explained that 1. paving of parking area west of mill will be completed this year. The area will have striping for ten parking spots, one being handicap, and angle striping in front of dry hydrant. 2. No parking signs will be on east side of hill with 5 parallel parking spots on west side of hill. 3. Looking to pave easement (fire road) area from mill parking to State Rd 67. 4. In Spring it is planned to do paving on east side of mill and sidewalk. And 5. ARPA money could also be used for tree and brush clean up around the mill and races with director's approval. Bids could gotten.

- 6. New lights are needed for outdoor tree. Lenny will check with Mark to see if gotten.
- 7. The memorial bench for Dick Edwards, after some delivery confusion, was received and is waiting for assembly.
- 8. Porta Potty will be picked up the end of Oct and bill will be placed in door or in donation slot.
