Meeting called to order at 6:13 p.m. by Pat Brown, Pres.

Treasurer's Report, dated April 30, 2026:

President Pat Brown and Treasurer Sue Hafermann both unanimously elected to serve another 2-year term.

Old Business

1. 2025 Love Light Event: Choir and Santa will be considered again for the coming year, in addition to adding the train (if weather permits).
2. Year in Review for Facebook Page- Tabled until September.
3. Easter Egg Hunt: Four glasses were sold; Tom purchased the remaining 2 after the meeting.
4. Bemis Voucher Spring Fundraiser: Vouchers are still available through directors as well as available at Dins Mini-Mart and Belle Ami Salon. Dates of sale may need to be adjusted for 2027 as it was learned that people were already going to the nursery before our launch on Mother's Day.
5. Mill Building/Grounds Maintenance
 - Garden Shed Update: When completed, it will be delivered to the Mill, rolled off a trailer and put in the appropriate location.
 - Update Donation Sign: Larry offered to complete this project.
 - Split Rail Fencing: Supplies will be purchased through Menards and a text sent to directors to assist with installation.
 - Water Trough Repair: On hold until raceway is drained. Jerry's assistance is needed. Will need to measure for adding a rail ladder to the area.
 - Gutter Repair: No update.
 - Mill Safety: Measurements are needed and will need people to help install the catwalk.
 - Turbine: It is in need of attention; however, water needs to be drained and the catwalk installed before it can be addressed.
 - Outcropping (Kranig recognition): Rachel presented a quote from Custom Craft Trophies in Plymouth. Cost of plaque would be approximately \$65. Pat has the info that needs to be on it. Motion by Rachel and seconded by Moe to proceed with purchase of plaque.
 - Porta Potty: Contract has been secured, and porta potty has already been delivered.
 - Dam/Cedar Corp Update/Access: Town is working with Cedar Corp to secure funding.
 - Muskrat Locator: A number of them have been removed. Motion by Tom and seconded by Larry to approve payment. Question was raised as to whether any fish are left in pond. Outreach to Long Lake Fishing Club to restock ponds was discussed.
 - Rocks Along Hwy F: Project for this summer; Karen indicated it is likely additional rocks will be needed.

- Weed Trimming: Confirmed that David Hartman will do this, and Larry will reach out to him about what needs to be done.
 - Pier Near Dam: Because of access for Walleyes for Tomorrow project for the next couple years, consideration as to where a convenient location for a pier needs to be discussed. Suggestion made to contact local businesses if they would be interested in contributing to a pier.
 - Shipping Container being offered by Town of Osceola: Confirmation is needed as to whether or not the baseball group is no longer in need of it.
6. OKTOBERFEST
- Beer Truck: Rachel offered to handle this.
 - Sportsmen Club will again be reserved for parking that day. Golf carts will again be utilized and need to be secured. Porta-potty has been reserved. Sponsor letter needs to be updated.
 - Suggestion made to place a banner at the corner of Hwy 67 and Cty Rd G well in advance of event for more exposure during the summer.
 - Committee will soon resume meetings for the event.
7. Engraved Brick Fund Raiser: Tabled until after Cedar Corp Dam project is completed.
8. Town Hall Mezzanine Cleanup: Tabled until a later date.
9. Mill Tours for 2026: Will coordinate with Jean upon her return.
10. Walleyes for Tomorrow Project: Overall project went well for them. Algae was an issue for them, but they were able to get fish in the nets. The plan is for them to return again for the next couple of years. Fencing at Twohig access still needs to be finalized.
11. Miller Memorial Tree(s): Jay has been provided with a supplier and recommended tree. Karen will coordinate with Jay as to where to plant.
12. Future Events at Mill: “Jam at the Dam”, a music event; “Thrill at the Mill”, a Halloween event; and a tractor show. Invitation for Dave Thompson to attend June’s meeting .

New Business

1. Mill Park will now be included in the Town of Osceola’s new insurance policy through Rural Mutual.
2. Lenny suggested life preserver(s) (1 or 2) be made available on the property.
