Sealed (paper) bids for Sunnyslope Avenue Resurfacing, LRIP–TRI Project, will be received by the Town of Osceola (Fond du Lac County), Town Clerk at the Town Hall, W1476 County Road F, Campbellsport, Wisconsin 53010, by 2:00 pm (local time), on August 20, 2026; and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The work, in general, will include the approximate quantities and items listed below:

Pulverize Existing Pavement/Base Course: 4,000 S.Y.
Hot Mix Asphalt Pavement: 870 Tons
Excavating Below Subgrade: 200 C.Y.
Sawcutting Pavement: 600 L.F.
Driveway Removal & Replacement: 6,550 S.F.
Grass Shoulder Restoration: 1,000 S.Y.

The proposals shall be submitted on the forms furnished with the specifications. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid bond of a bonding company duly authorized to do business in the State of Wisconsin in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the proposal. This proposal guarantee shall be subject to forfeiture as provided by law.
