RESOLUTION NO. 2026-4

Resolution Opposing the Siting of the Proposed 765 Transmission Line in Sauk County

WHEREAS, the 765 Transmission Line is proposed to be constructed through portions of Sauk County; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Winfield recognizes the importance of reliable electric transmission, but is concerned about the potential negative impacts of the proposed route on local communities, agricultural land, natural resources, and property values; and

WHEREAS, residents and stakeholders have expressed significant concerns regarding environmental, health, and economic impacts associated with the construction and operation of the transmission line; and

WHEREAS, alternative routes and technologies may exist that would minimize adverse impacts on Sauk County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Winfield that it hereby opposes the siting of the proposed 765 transmission line along the currently proposed route within Sauk County;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board urges state and federal regulatory agencies to consider alternative routes and to fully evaluate the environmental, economic, and social impacts of the project;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the town clerk is directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Midcontinent Grid Solutions-Wisconsin (via connect@mgs wisconsin.com), State Senator Sarah Keyeski, and State Representative Tony Kurtz.
