Ordinance 2026-02

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPLIT SHIFTS FOR ELECTION OFFICIALS

The Town Board of the Town of Sherman, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30 (1), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance. This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 or more sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

- A. There may be multiple shifts for election officials during each election period. Times will be set by the Town Clerk and may change from election to election based on voter volume expected and availability of election officials. On election day, the first shift shall commence 30 minutes prior to the opening of the polls and the final shift shall conclude after completion of all required election duties that follow the closure of the polls.
- B. The Town may appoint one additional inspector to serve at each polling place without regard to party affiliation who shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and who should be available to substitute for other election officials if they must leave the room during the voting process.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.30, Wis. stats.
