Notice is hereby given by the Town of Burlington, Racine County, Wisconsin, that it will receive sealed bids for paving of the following roads until 12:00 PM local time, February 27, 2026 in the office of the **Town of Burlington located at 32288 Bushnell Road, Burlington, Wisconsin**. Bids will be publicly opened and read at that time. Bid specs may be obtained at the Town of Burlington Town Hall. The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any informalities in bidding, or to accept the bid(s) which best serve the interest of the Town.

ROADS: Maple Grove Dr. starting at Bohner Dr. ending at Fish Hatchery Rd. Approx 1630 feet

Length and width of roads are approximate. Road length and width are to be verified by the contractor. Bid price for each road will be complete price, no estimates will be accepted.

Contract documents may be examined at the **Town of Burlington, 32288 Bushnell Road, Burlington, WI**.

Proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in the amount of not less than 5 percent of the maximum bid, payable to the Treasurer of the **Town of Burlington** as a guarantee that the bidder, if the bid is accepted, will execute, and file the Contract. The certified check is returnable to the bidder immediately after the signing of the Contract.

A performance bond in the amount of 100 percent of the total bid price, a certificate of insurance, together with an executed contract, will be required of the successful bidder.

The owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The contractor shall be pre-qualified by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to perform the work in this bid.

SPECIFICATIONS

GENERAL

All contracting procedures, work and materials supplied under this proposal shall conform to the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, 1996 edition, and all subsequent revisions and supplementary specifications, of the Wisconsin Division of Highways, Department of Transportation. The special provisions in this proposal shall supplement and take precedence over the above-mentioned specifications.

The **Town of Burlington**, the issuer of this bid proposal, shall hereinafter be referred to as "the owner".

BID BOND AND PERFORMANCE BOND

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check payable to the **Town of Burlington**, or by a bid bond, as a guarantee for the amount specified in the bid. The certified check is returnable to the bidder immediately after the signing of the contract.

Successful bidders shall furnish the owner with a performance bond equal to 100% of the contracted amount (per State Statute 779.14).

INSURANCE

The contractor shall furnish and deliver to the owner a certificate of insurance for worker's compensation and an umbrella certificate of liability and property insurance in the minimum amount of three million dollars before beginning work and shall notify the owner immediately of any cancellation or change in insurance coverage.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

The contractor will be responsible for all traffic control, including furnishing and maintaining all signs, flags, flag-persons, barricades, and lights where required, to protect the safety of the traveling public, all in accordance with the FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION AND WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 1988 edition and its supplements. All work will be done under traffic unless otherwise directed by the owner.

COMPLETION

All work is to be completed prior to **October 1, 2026**.

ASPHALT CONCRETE

CONSTRUCTION PROCEDURES

Surfacing – Base Course - Asphalt concrete construction shall conform to Section 407 of the WisDOT Standard Specifications, 1996 Edition. 2.25 Inches of asphalt for the binder course and 2 inches for the surface course. Wedging may be required in areas where substantial leveling is needed. Wedging shall be done as directed by the owner after project review with the contractor. Milling of driveways, intersections, and manholes incidental to asphalt price. Driveways shall be paved integrally with the traffic lane.

Tack Coat – A tack coat is required to be applied to existing surface prior to overlay. The final sweeping and surface cleaning shall be done by the paving contractor just ahead of paving and this cleaning shall be considered incidental cost to the paving.

PRODUCTION

The contractor shall provide adequate trucks and paving train equipment to assure a continuous paving operation and avoid frequent delays.

After the asphaltic concrete paving has started, the contractor shall proceed to complete the project at the earliest possible date. If the contractor should determine it necessary to stop the paving operation, the contractor shall make a request to the owner for permission to stop work.

ASPHALTIC CONCRETE PAVEMENT MATERIALS SHALL BE MIX TYPE: 5LT 58-28 S

The asphalt cement shall be 3LT 58-28 S hot mix asphalt. The contractor shall provide a current mix design that will be used on the project.

ASPHALTIC MIXTURE ACCEPTANCE PROGRAM

The contractor shall provide and maintain a quality control program. A quality control program is defined as all activities, including mix design, process control inspection, sampling and testing, and necessary adjustments in the process that are related to the production of a hot mix asphaltic pavements which meets the requirement of the specifications. ASPHALT CONCRETE

Asphaltic Concrete Basis Of Payment When By The Ton

An asphaltic pavement mixture of the type or types included in the contract shall be measured by the ton of mixed aggregates and bituminous material laid and compacted in place. The price shall be full compensation for producing, furnishing, and placing all materials including asphalt cement, and for all labor, tools, equipment, testing and incidentals necessary to complete the work.

Payment will be made only for supplied material accompanied by a ticket containing the following information:

1. Ticket number, date, and time
2. Type of material
3. Net weight

Copies of the tickets shall be given to the owner. Load tickets must be from a certified scale.

BASE PATCHING

This item shall consist of supplying, preparation, placement, and compaction of asphaltic mixture in accordance with Section 308.3.3 of WisDOT Standard Specifications, 1996 Edition.

All base patching shall be saw cut.

The depth of the asphalt will be: Two (2) inches for all areas marked with paint

The extent and nature of this item will be determined by the owner and transmitted to the contractor prior to bid opening.

The basis of payment for this item shall be by the square yard.
