

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-25
TOWN OF MILTON
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ELECTION OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 7.30 (1)(a) authorizes the Town Board to authorize split shifts for elections; and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 7.30 (1)(b) authorizes the Town Board to appoint one additional inspector to serve at each polling place without regard to party affiliation who shall serve as a greeter and substitute for other election officials.

WHEREAS, the Town Board passed a Resolution on December 19, 2007 which authorized (a) a reduction in the number of election officials for each polling place to no fewer than three; (b) the Clerk to determine the number of election officials necessary to adequately staff each election; (c) the Clerk to utilize split poll worker shifts when necessary and (d) the Clerk to assist poll workers in tabulating the ballots;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Milton, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

Split-shifts may be used at any election. The Clerk has the authority to determine the number of shifts necessary to adequately staff the election and ensure the retention and well-being of election officials.

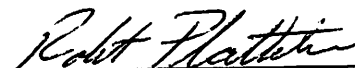
The Clerk is authorized to appoint one additional election official, as the Clerk deems necessary, to serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under Wis. Stat. § 60.80.
