REQUESTING REFORM OF NWTC PRACTICES
AND FUNDING POLICIES
RESOLUTION NO. 1-2003

WHEREAS the Town of Gardner is assessed a portion of the funds needed to operate the Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (NWTC)

AND WHEREAS the Town of Gardner and Door County as a whole voted “No” in a 2001 Referendum addressing increased funding levels,

AND WHEREAS the technical education system recently designated that it no longer be known as technical “institute” but had in practice and effect, achieved the status of a technical “college” in the State of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Gardner does hereby request that the Statutes which created the Technical System be revisited by the Wisconsin Legislature with particular attention devoted to revising the current operational, decision making and taxing authority of the Technical College System in Wisconsin and its Board of Directors;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Gardner recommends that as a College System operating in the State of Wisconsin, that the Technical Colleges should be operated as all other state-supported colleges, both in oversight and funding, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Gardner request that the Town Clerk send copies of this Resolution to the Wisconsin Town’s Association, Senator Alan Lasee, Rep. Garey Bies, and appropriate legislative committees.
