HOW TO GET A LIBRARY CARD AT NO COST TO YOU!!!

To get a library card you must:

- Be 8 years or older (Please call for questions regarding age)
- Bring with you, to the library, two pieces of identification showing your current name, physical and mailing address.
- Fill out an application form and show you ID to the person at the circulation desk.
- Your information will be entered and a card issued to you. That simple!!!

FYI: Umatilla County libraries all share the same circulation system so you only need ONE card for all libraries in the county. If you already have a **BARCODED** card form another library in the Umatilla County it is useable at the Stanfield Public Library.

Also... upon receiving your library card, there is a 30 day probationary period where you may only check out 2 items per card at a time.

Check Outs:

- Book check outs for 21 day
- Magazines check outs for 7 days
- Video check outs for 7 days

<u>Fines:</u>

- Book \$.20 per day/ \$5 max
- Magazines \$.20 per day/ \$5 max
- Videos \$.20 per day/ \$5 max

<u>Parents:</u> Please realize that once your child has a Library Card, he or she has the right to use the library computers with Internet Access. <u>The Library is not</u> responsible for monitoring the Web Sites your child accesses.
