The City of Stanfield is currently accepting applications for a full time Police Officer with the Stanfield Police Department. Applications will be accepted until the position has been filled.

- Pass Police Background Check including a medical exam, psychological evaluation and drug testing, and Pre-hiring test.

- Complete Oregon Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) requirements for employment including: No Felony, drug related or turpitude offenses, Successful completion of the DPSST basic police academy, and pass the Oregon Physical Agilities Test (ORPAT).
