



Public Works Employment

The City of Minonk is accepting applications for full-time employment as a laborer in the public works department. Applications may be picked up at Minonk City Hall, 670 Chestnut Street Minonk Il. 61760, during regular business hours, 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., M-F. All applicants must complete and submit a City of Minonk employment application form.

Preferred applicants must have a valid Illinois Driver's License, have or willing to obtain an Illinois Class B CDL with air brake endorsement, also be willing to obtain an Illinois Department of Agriculture Pesticide license within 6 months of hiring date. Must have a high school diploma or equivalent to be selected.

Duties will include, but are not limited to, the operation of gravel trucks, backhoe, skid loader and other city equipment to aid in road repairs, water and sewer line repairs, cement work, and tree service. Must be able to lift 50lbs on a regular basis and manually repair water and sewer lines safely in trenches under extreme weather or difficult site conditions. Must have basic knowledge of computers and their function. Overtime and week-end chore rotation is required. Mechanical and general maintenance experience such as plumbing, electrical, building trades is a plus but not required. This position will be under the supervision of the Public Works Supervisor.

Upon selection applicant will have to pass a comprehensive physical and drug test.

Benefits Include Paid Holidays, Generous paid time off (Vacation, personal, and sick time), Annual uniform allowance, Health insurance, and Illinois Municipal retirement Fund (IMRF).

Applications must be received by 12 pm on **Friday April 17th, 2026**, to be considered for this position. The City of Minonk is an EOE/AA employer.
