

Town of Stockbridge

How to register your animal:

1. **Town office** – the town office is open to public. Hours are Monday by appointment Tuesday – Thursday 7:30am – 4:30pm and Friday from 7:30am to noon.
2. **By mail** – mail to the town Stockbridge, PO Box 39, Stockbridge, VT 05772
3. **By drop box** - the drop box to the left of the front door at the town office

Documentation needed to renew your dog license or to register a new dog:

Renewal:

1. Current rabies certificate
2. Current physical/mailling address and phone number
3. Payment per fee schedule – payable to the town of Stockbridge by check, money order, or cash

New: (Dogs 6 months or older)

1. Current rabies certificate
2. Dogs name/age/weight/breed/color
3. Documentation showing that your dog's neutered or spayed status
4. Physical/mailling address and phone number
5. Payment per fee schedule – payable to the town of Stockbridge by check, money order, or cash

STATE STATUTE SUMMARY

Annual Licensing Deadline for Existing Pet Owners: April 1

A person who fails to license a dog or wolf-hybrid in the required manner may be fined up to \$500.00. [20 V.S.A. § 3550(a)]

Minimum Fee Schedule:

All licensing requirements apply to dogs and wolf-hybrids (DWH) age 6 months or older. Per Vermont law, municipalities may levy an optional additional surcharge fee, not to exceed \$10.00, to enforce its animal and rabies control program. [20 V.S.A. § 3581(c)(2)]

* DWH adopted between April 1 and October 1: Owner has 30 days to license from time of adoption.

Working Farm Dog Fee: Add \$5.00
