

## ROCHESTER STOCKBRIDGE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

### ANNUAL MEETING WARNING

The legal voters of the Rochester Stockbridge Unified District, consisting of the towns of Rochester and Stockbridge, are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Stockbridge Campus of the Rochester Stockbridge Unified District, in Rochester, Vermont on **May 5, 2026 at 6:00 PM** to consider and act upon the following articles (1-10) and to discuss the article to be voted upon by Australian ballot (Article 11 only).

- Article 1: To elect a Moderator who shall assume office immediately and serve a one-year term or until the election and qualification of a successor.
- Article 2: To elect a School District Clerk who shall assume office immediately and serve a one-year term or until the election and qualification of a successor.
- Article 3: To elect a School District Treasurer who shall assume office July 1, 2026 and serve a one-year term or until the election and qualification of a successor.
- Article 4: To fix the salaries in the amount of \$2,000 for Board Chair, \$1,350 each for Vice Chair & Clerk, \$1,100 for all other members for the School District Officers for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Article 5: To fix the salary in the amount of \$1,300 for the School District Treasurer for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Article 6: Shall the voters authorize the School Board to borrow money by issuance of notes not in excess of anticipated revenue for the fiscal year July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027?
- Article 7: To hear and act upon the reports of the School District Directors and officers.
- Article 8: Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend \$5,536,267 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Rochester Stockbridge Unified District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$13,126.92 which is 5.87% higher than per pupil spending for the current year.
- Article 9: To transact any other business which may legally come before this meeting.
- Article 10: To adjourn the meeting

Voters of the Town of Rochester will vote at the Rochester Town Offices in Rochester, Vermont. The Polls will open on Wednesday, May 6, 2026 at 10:00 AM and close at 7:00 PM.

Voters of the Town of Stockbridge will vote at the Stockbridge Town Offices in Stockbridge, Vermont. The Polls will open on Wednesday, May 6, 2026 at 10:00 AM and close at 7:00 PM.

The legal voters of the Rochester Stockbridge Unified School District are further notified that voter qualification and registration relative to said meeting shall be as provided in Section 706(u) of Title 16, and Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.




