Re: Vermont Route 100 Roadway Rehabilitation

Dear Town of Stockbridge,

VTrans, with the assistance of VHB, is developing construction documents to complete a highway rehabilitation project of Vermont Route 100 through the Towns of Killington, Pittsfield, and Stockbridge. The project begins at the intersection with US Route 4 in Killington and continues northerly approximately 10.8 miles to the intersection with Vermont Route 100 in Stockbridge. The work to be performed under this project includes roadway rehabilitation with minor widening of the existing highway, new pavement markings and signs, guardrail improvements, and drainage infrastructure improvements where appropriate.

Construction for this project is currently anticipated with drainage infrastructure improvements in 2027 and roadway rehabilitation in 2028, with active construction operations likely occurring between the months of April and October each year. Our current design schedule has final edits to the contract documents being completed by September 30th. We ask that any input from the Town be provided to VHB prior to September 18 so further coordination can be undertaken prior to the September 30 contract document finalization.
