



**CANDIDATE FILING NOTICE
CASS COUNTY MINNESOTA
NOTICE OF OFFICES TO BE VOTED FOR
AT THE STATE GENERAL ELECTION**

The following is the notice of federal and state offices that will be voted for at the state general election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The filing period for United States Senator, United States Representative, State Senator, State Representative, Governor and Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor, Attorney General, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Judge of the Minnesota Court of Appeals, Judge of the District Court, and County offices begins at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 19, 2026, and ends at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 2, 2026. Note: Filing offices will be closed Monday, May 25, 2026, in observance of Memorial Day.

The place of filing for federal offices is the Office of the Minnesota Secretary of State, Veterans Services Building, 20 West 12th Street, St. Paul, MN 55155. The place of filing for state offices (including judicial offices) is with the Office of the Secretary of State or with the county auditor of the county in which the candidate resides. The place of filing for Cass County offices is the Office of the Cass County Auditor-Treasurer, Cass County Courthouse, 303 Minnesota Ave. W., PO Box 3000, Walker, MN 56484-3000. Candidates may file in person or by mail if the filing is received during the filing period. Candidates who will be absent from the state during the filing period and meet the requirements of Minnesota Statutes section 204B.09, subdivision 1a, may arrange to file during the seven days immediately preceding the candidate's absence from the state. This notice is provided pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 204B.33 and is based on current law.

Candidates for the following offices must file at the Office of the Minnesota Secretary of State: FEDERAL OFFICES
One United States Senator and One United States Representative (One office per district, districts 1-8; District 8-Cass County)

Candidates for the following offices must file either at the Office of the Minnesota Secretary of State or the office of the county auditor of the county in which they reside: STATE LEGISLATIVE OFFICES Cass County; One State Senator for each of Districts 2, 5, and 6. One State Representative for each of Districts 2B, 5A, 5B, and 6A. **STATE EXECUTIVE OFFICES** Governor and Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor, and Attorney General. **JUDICIAL OFFICES** Three seats Associate Justice seat 1 (Hennesy), seat 2 (Gaïtas), and seat 4 (Thissen); five seats Court of Appeals - seat 1 (Bentley), seat 7 (5th Congressional District) (Bond), seat 13 (Cochran), seat 15 (3rd Congressional District) (Ross), and seat 18 (Harris); twelve seats Ninth District Court Judge-seat 1 (Adam), seat 2 (Mallie), seat 4 (Halverson), seat 5 (Wimmer), seat 12 (McBroom), seat 13 (Hawley), seat 14 (Lorsbach), seat 15 (Yon), seat 19 (Austad), seat 20 (Grover), seat 21 (Aanes), seat 22 (Duffy)

Candidates for the following offices must file at the Office of the Cass County Auditor-Treasurer: COUNTY OFFICES
One County Commissioner four-year term for each of the following districts: Districts 1 and 4; One Special Election for County Commissioner District 3 to fill a vacancy in term expiring January 8, 2029. One for each County Sheriff and County Attorney; one Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor four-year term for each of the nominating Districts 1 and 5.

Candidates for city, township, school district and United Hospital District offices (without primaries) may file for office at the respective clerk's office beginning July 14, 2026, through July 28, 2026.
