Town of Longwood, Clark County

The Town Board of the Town of Longwood, Clark County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.15(2), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.


This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:


- A. The following town highways in the Town of Longwood are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s.348.16 (2), Wis stats., unless increased by town ordinance: Fairground Avenue from Hwy 29 to Eddy Road and Colby Factory Road from Hwy 73 to Hwy O.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance. *
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the weight limits set forth in s. 34816 (2), Wis. Stats. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$250 nor more than \$263, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of the ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violation.

This ordinance is effective on June 1, 2026. Ordinance #051326.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis. Stats.
