

DRIVEWAY ORDINANCE

DRIVEWAY ORDINANCE FOR THE TOWN OF KEYSTONE BAYFIELD COUNTY, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that there be authority to regulate private driveways entering public town roads;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Keystone, Bayfield County, State of Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of Keystone that the following regulations shall apply to the construction of newly constructed private driveways:

PRIVATE DRIVEWAY CONSTRUCTION

- (1) APPROVAL REQUIRED: No person shall establish or construct a private driveway, road or other access from a private property line to the traveled portion of any public town road without first filing an application and obtaining a driveway permit from the Town Board.
- (2) SPECIFICATIONS: The location of said driveway shall be approved by the Town Board. Each driveway shall have a culvert at a minimum 15" diameter at the ditch line, unless special permission is obtained from the Town Board. All cost of construction of said driveway, including the cost of the culvert, shall be paid by the property owner requesting the permit. No culvert shall be less than 40 feet in length and may be longer if so determined by the Town Board. All driveways will have a minimum 20' setback from any nearby property lines. Either a Board member or Town Road Supervisor must be present at sometime during the construction of the driveway.
- (3) PENALTY: Any person violating this section may be fined not less than \$200.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 and default of payment of said fine shall result in referral to the Bayfield County District Attorney for further prosecution.

This ordinance shall take effect after publication in the Daily Press, as required by law and also posted on the bulletin boards located at the Keystone Town Hall at the intersection of Klobucher Rd and Co Hwy F, the Keystone Transfer Station on North Fork Rd, and the Saint Florian Church on Keystone Rd near Co. Hwy E.
