TOWN OF KEYSTONE
ATV/UTV ORDINANCE

(Amendment to previously proposed & adopted Ordinance #000501A)

THE TOWN OF KEYSTONE, BAYFIELD COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. All regulations regarding recreational ATV'S/UTV'S as defined in section 340.01 (2g) and State Statutes section 23.33 and NR 64 enacted by the State of Wisconsin which are not covered by this ordinance shall be in full force and effect.
2. The intent of this Ordinance is to establish routes within the Town of Keystone whereby ATV's/UTV'S may reach the trails and routes located outside the Town of Keystone. It is not intended that this Ordinance establish our town roads for the purpose other than leaving or entering the town.
3. All ATV/UTV routes within the Town of Keystone shall be marked by uniform marking signs which conform with regulations of the State of Wisconsin, Department of Transportation and Natural Resources, and shall be open per State Statute 23.33 (1) (C) and shall be open only if properly marked / signed.
4. ATV'S / UTV'S shall not exceed 30 miles per hour while operating on town roads within the limits of the Town of Keystone.
5. State traffic Forfeiture Laws Adopted. Except as otherwise specifically provided in the Ordinance, all provisions of Chapter NR 64 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code and Section 23.33 of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

6. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance not covered by Chapter NR 64 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code and Section 23.33 of the Wisconsin State Statutes shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$50.00 together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of the forfeiture and cost of prosecution, shall be incarcerated in the Bayfield County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid but not exceeding ten (10) days.

The foregoing Ordinance was adopted at a Town Board Meeting on the seventeenth day of May, 2000; and amended by said Town Board on the First day of May, 2001.
