The Town of Metomen will receive sealed Bids for the **Carter Road Double Chip Seal and Watson Road Double Chip Seal. Single chip seal for Radio Road and Sheldon Road at the offices of Township at N6971 Hwy 44-49, Ripon, WI 54971** at the time and date stated above, at which time, all Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Work for which Bids are asked includes the following:

Contract No. 1: Carter Road Double Chip Seal, Watson Road Double Chip Seal – Double chip seal with 3/8 inch black granite chips on the 1st coat and 1/4 inch on the 2nd coat for both roads:

- Carter Road with length of 5,087ft and road width of 21ft between intersection at route CTH E, towards Searle Rd,
- Watson Road with length of 3,575ft and road width of 21ft between intersections at route CTH E, towards Searle Rd,

Contract No. 2: Radio Rd. (Liner Rd to Hwy 44) .21 Miles (1,150' X 21') Single Seal Coat using FA2 1/4" Black Granite Stone

Contract No 3: Radio Rd. (Hwy 44 to Sheldon Rd) 1.5 Miles (7,930' X 21') Single Seal Coat Using 1/4" FA2 Black Granite Stone and 22-44 Tons of Various Cold Mix Wedging

Contract No 4: Sheldon Rd. (County E to Radio Rd) .97 Miles (5,130' X 21') Single Seal Coat using 1/4" FA2 Black Granite Stone and 44-66 Tons of Various Cold Mix Wedging

Contract No 5: Sheldon Rd. (Radio Rd to Hwy 49) .97 Miles (5,130' X 21') Single Seal Coat using 1/4" FA2 Black Granite Stone and 132-156 Tons of Various Cold Mix Wedging

Contract No 6: Watson Rd. (End of Double seal to Searle Rd) .28 Miles (1,510' X 20') Single Seal Coat using 1/4" FA2 Black Granite Stone and 286-308 Tons of Various Cold Mix Wedging

Cold Mix Wedging shall be applied to various sections of the roadway directed by the town that show deviations to level and straighten out prior to a seal coat application.

*The cold mix paving asphaltic material shall be CM or SC Asphalt. It shall be mixed in a plant equipped with weigh belt-conveyer and automatic computer-controlled proportioning of asphalt to aggregate.

*All aggregates to be used in the asphaltic mixtures shall be 100% virgin in nature. No recycled [RAP] asphaltic aggregates will be accepted.

* Cold Mix must be produced and used in a continuous operation and may not be stockpiled to be used at a later date.

The **Watson and Carter Road DOUBLE CHIP SEAL** projects is funded by the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) under Project Number: 19733, sponsored by the Town of Metomen.

Bids may not be withdrawn within 60 days after the date of the bid opening. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, and to award the Contract to the Bidder, who in the judgment of the Owner, will best serve the interest of the Owner.
