**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT SPECIAL CHARGES FOR AMBULANCE SERVICE FOR TAX YEAR 2025**

The Town Board of the Town of Algoma, Winnebago County, Wisconsin by this resolution on proper notice with a quorum and roll call vote of the majority of the Town Board present and voting hereby resolves and orders as follows:

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 60.565, the Town of Algoma is required to contract for or operate and maintain ambulance services for the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oshkosh currently provides ambulance services to the Town of Algoma on a fee-for-service model; and

**WHEREAS**, the residents and property owners in the Town of Algoma expect and require ambulance service to respond in emergencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Algoma has previously funded ambulance services by utilizing general tax dollars collected from taxpaying properties within the Town.

**WHEREAS**, Wis. Stat. Secs. 60.565 and 66.0627(2) allows the Town Board of Town of Algoma to determine and charge a reasonable fee for providing ambulance service to properties located within the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, due to budgetary constraints and to more equitably spread the cost of providing the availability of ambulance service to the entire Town, the Town of Algoma Town Board has determined that is necessary to impose the cost of ambulance service on properties in the form of a special charge.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Town Board for the Town of Algoma a special charge for the provision of ambulance service for 2025 shall be \$67.29 per property.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town of Algoma shall bill the special charge pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes and such charge shall be due and payable as listed on such bill.
