### **Tree Program:**

In conjunction with Trees Louisville, the City of Wellington offers a tree planting program to its residents. Trees can now be planted in your front easement, if you choose. A free permit is necessary to plant a tree in the easement. More information on how to get a permit can be found on our tree program page on the website.

With the city program, Trees Louisville will place flags in arborist-suggested locations so homeowners can make an informed decision about planting. 811 will ensure the area is safe with regards to utility lines. Trees include mulch, stakes, a water well, and a tree care brochure. Homeowners are responsible for watering their own tree after planting. Another round of tree planting through Trees Louisville will be available this Fall; stay tuned for more information, or contact Taylor at [Commissioner1@CityofWellingtonKY.com](mailto:Commissioner1@CityofWellingtonKY.com).

Residents may also elect to purchase their own tree outside of the tree program. If planted in the easement, it must meet guidelines outlined in the city ordinances, including obtaining a free permit from the city. Please help us re-build our city's tree canopy by considering a shade producing tree for your easement or front yard!

### **Parking Issues**

Please remember there is no overnight parking allowed on the city's streets between the hours of 12:00am until 6:00am. Also be aware that there are several places that do not allow parking on the streets at any time, these areas are marked with signs. Typically, it is one side of every street to allow for emergency vehicles if needed. With increased foot activity, and as always, do not block the sidewalk with your vehicle.

### **How to Secure Dumpster/POD permit**

Our residents are always busy doing projects and improvements on their homes and properties. If you need to utilize a temporary storage facility, such as a POD, or if you are securing a dumpster, our city ordinances require a permit to be displayed at your home. The dumpster or storage facility may not be placed in the right of way and permits are limited to 30 calendar days. Applications for permits are available on the
