Trash, Recycling and Yard Waste Pick-up

Ecotech provides the City of Wellington with weekly collection of garbage and yard waste and biweekly collection of recycling. One bulk item pickup per month may be scheduled for curbside pickup by calling Ecotech customer service at 502-935-1130, Monday – Friday, 8am – 4:30pm. The collection day for all services is Tuesday. All

containers must be removed from the curb by 11:59pm on Tuesday or subject to penalty. If a waste pickup is ever missed, please contact Ecotech customer service at 502-935-1130. Parking Issues

Please remember there is no overnight parking allowed on the city's streets between the hours of 12:00am and 6:00am. In addition, there is no parking in the designated fire lanes and your car should not block the sidewalk. When parked on the street during approved hours, all four tires should be on the street and not in the grass.

How to Secure Dumpster/POD permit

Our residents are always busy doing projects and improvements on their homes and properties. If you need to utilize a temporary storage facility, such as a POD, or if you are securing a dumpster, our city ordinances require a permit. The dumpster or storage facility may not be placed in the right of way and permits are limited to 30 calendar days before renewal is required.
