The plan contains maps and other descriptive materials relating to the elements in the plan;

The plan has been adopted by a majority vote of the entire Plan Committee, which the clerk has recorded in the minutes; The Plan Committee clerk is directed to send a copy of the comprehensive plan adopted by the committee to the governmental units specified in sec. 66.1001(4), Wis. Statutes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Committee recommends that the Town Board of the Town of Belvidere, Buffalo County, Wisconsin adopts the Town of Belvidere Comprehensive Plan.
