STATE OF WISCONSIN TOWN OF BELVIDERE, BUFFALO COUNTY Ordinance No. 2012 - 3A

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE TOWN OF BELVIDERE, BUFFALO COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of BELVIDERE, Buffalo County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to sections (59.69(3) Wis. Statutes, the Town of BELVIDERE is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of Wis. Statutes.

SECTION 2. The Town Board of the Town of BELVIDERE, Buffalo County, Wisconsin has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of Wis. Statutes.

SECTION 3. The Planning Committee of the Town of BELVIDERE, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the entire committee recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document entitled "TOWN OF BELVIDERE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN", containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of Wis. Statutes.

SECTION 4. The Town of BELVIDERE has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of Wis. Statutes.

SECTION 5. The Town Board of the Town of BELVIDERE, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, does, by the enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "TOWN OF BELVIDERE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN", pursuant to section 66.1001(4)© of the Wis. Statutes.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority of the members of the town board and as required by law.
