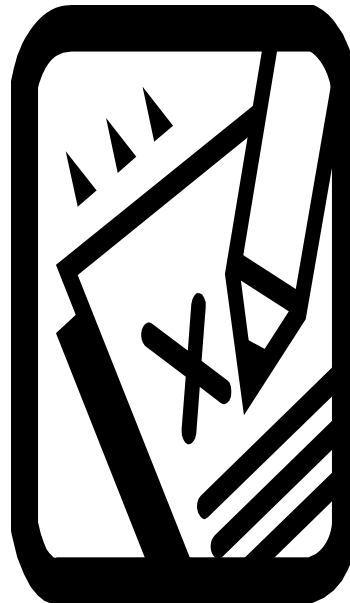

Each year residents are given the opportunity to meet at the Town Hall with the assessor during Open Book to discuss their current property assessment. If you choose after that meeting to appear before the Board of Review to con-

test your assessment you will need to submit the necessary objection form in advance and receive an assigned appearance time from the Town Clerk. The burden of proof lies with the property holder to provide their case for change in assessment.

## Town of Port Burning Ordinance

Town Ordinance 2001-02 Regulating Burning of Grass, Brush, Rubbish and Related Materials and Fire Hazards. The following information is summarized, the complete ordinance can be viewed on the web at [www.co.ozaukee.wi.us](http://www.co.ozaukee.wi.us)

Any persons desiring to burn dry grass, leaves, brush, rubbish or related materials within the Town including but not limited to beach fires, bonfires, open-pit or other recreational fires shall notify the Ozaukee County Sheriff's De-

partment with name, address, time, date and place of burning materials to be burned and anticipated length of activity prior to commencing such burning. The persons burning shall observe reasonable fire safety precautions, and take all necessary action to have adequate manpower, water, shovels and other equipment present to control and control such fires throughout the duration of the burn. No burning shall occur when the wind velocity exceeds 15 mph. Fires shall be located a

safe distance from other buildings, structures. Failure to provide prior notice to the Sheriff's Department, failure to maintain, control or extinguish any fire resulting in the attendance of the fire department shall be charged to the person burning for the actual cost of the fire call.

No prior notice to the Sheriff's Department needs to be given for the burning of small amounts of dry residential grass, leaves, brush or rubbish in a heavy wire screen-covered barrel. However all other provisions of this ordinance shall apply to such burning activity.

## From the Plan Commission

This past winter the plan commission and town board completed and adopted A Comprehensive Plan 2035 for Smart Growth.

The Plan Commission continues working on the creation of a A-3 transitional zoning district in

the town. Work also continues on the development of a conservation subdivision ordinance. This ordinance will allow for controlled development while preserving the rural character that the residents have expressed as very important.

A concept plan has recently been reviewed for a proposed 6 lot subdivision at the corner of Sunset Road and Northwoods Road.

Arrow **does not take** brush, yard waste, large pieces of construction materials. You will be charged extra fee's for these items.

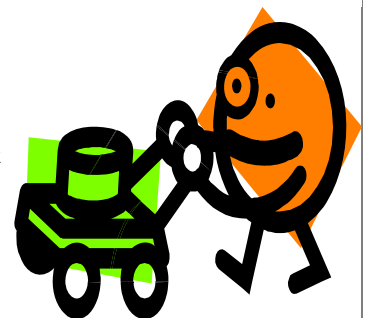
Arrow Disposal and Recycling Center is located at 3860 County Road H (284-1166) and is open at the following times for garbage and recycling drop off.
